

He married, firstly, Sibella, dau. of Archdeacon Gabriel Clarke (whose burial seo 12 May 1662), who died 2 March 1669; and secondly, Dorothy (baptized 10 Sep. 1639 at Crossgate, and buried there 24 Feb. 1709-10), dau. of Nicholas Heath, of Little Eden, co. Pal., Esq., but had issue by neither. He is buried near his father-in-law, the Archdeacon, and his M. I. bears the arms: On a chevron three garbs.
